



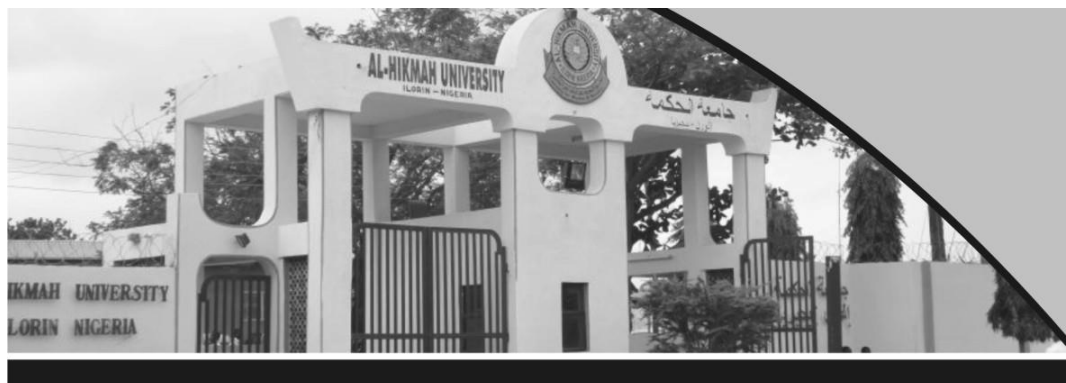

Peer Review Process

Every manuscript submitted to AJEC will first be evaluated by the managing editor. This initial evaluation is intended to check if:

- the manuscript fits the journal focus and editorial policy;
- the research is novel and original, without any scientific flaws, and uses sound methodologies;
- the manuscript is properly structured and it is written in good English;
- A manuscript which meets these minimal criteria will enter a double-blind review process. The manuscript will be sent to two anonymous reviewers, chosen according to their expertise in the field of the paper. Each reviewer will provide a detailed report on the manuscript, based on the AJEC review form, and will make recommendations to the editor regarding the acceptance or rejection of the paper. Both reviewers' reports, along with Editor's own comments, will be made available to the author;
- The author will be informed about the outcome of the review process, which could be:
 - Accept without revision.
 - Revise and resubmit - the author will be asked to make changes to the manuscript according to the reviewers' comments and suggestions and to resubmit the manuscript.
 - Reject – the editor will explain the reasons behind this editorial decision to the author.

Manuscript Requirements: All articles submitted should comply with the following guideline, otherwise, such articles will not be accepted.

Title Page: The first page should include: Article Title (Maximum of 12 words); Author(s) Details (full name, with surname in capital letter, affiliation, email address and cell-phone number). In case of multiple authors, correspondence author must be clearly specified. Structure abstract must not be more than 200 words. Keywords should not be more than five (5) words

Structured Abstract: Authors should supply structured abstract on the title page of the Article using the following sub-headings afterwards:

- Introduction
- Review of Relevant Literature
- Methodology
- Research Findings/Results
- Discussion of Results and Implication of Findings
- Conclusion and Recommendations

Format: All files should be submitted as a word document with font size of 12-inch Times New Roman.

Article Length: Manuscript should not be more than 20 pages (double-line spacing) including all texts and tables, references and appendices.

Headings: Headings must be concise with clear indication of the distinction between main headings and sub-headings. The prefer format is for first level headings to be presented in medium italics

References: References should be presented using the American Psychological Association (APA) referencing format 7th edition.
