Preamble

It is exactly two years ago, Monday, 13th July, 2020, that I assumed office as the Vice Chancellor of our great institution, Al-Hikmah University, Ilorin. Reflecting on those two years, we have cause to give thanks to Almighty Allah (SWT) for His Infinite Grace and Mercy, and for the modest feats recorded so far. I, hereby, commend all the important stakeholders for your commitment, steadfastness and prayers which have culminated in numerous accomplishments within the period. I wish to urge you all to rededicate yourselves to the realization of the University's vision of transforming it as a foremost private Islamic Faith-based University in Nigeria with global recognition.

Modest feats attained include:

- 1. Construction of farm houses at the Faculty of Agriculture, Igbaja campus
- 2. Successful deployment of ICT facilities for academic and administrative activities
- 3. Successful take-off of the Centre for Peace and Security Studies and holding of the Maiden Public Lecture of the centre on September 9, 2021.
- 4. In collaboration with the Stakeholders Forum, the completion of 700-capacity CBT Centre currently stocked with 275 units of computers for JAMB and allied examinations. The Centre secured JAMB approval to conduct 2022 UTME and the outing was very successful.
- 5. Gradual movement of two faculties (Education and Management Sciences) to Atere Main Campus in the 2021/2022 academic session. Currently, the University Management has put in place adequate logistics to ease movement of staff and students between the campuses, consolidate security through perimeter fencing, improve accommodation, and water supply, among others.
- 6. Completion of two hostel projects at Atere and Igbaja campuses each supported by H.E. Rt. Hon. Aminu Bello Masari, Executive Governor of Katsina State and Islamic Solidarity Fund of the

- Organisation of Islamic Co-operation in Jeddah, Saudi Arabia, respectively.
- 7. Staff welfare support through accelerated staff development grant for both academic and non-teaching staff
- 8. Students Welfare and Support Services, including the construction of a standard gymnasium, and 5-aside football field; provision of hostel recreation facilities, food and snacks bay, etc.
- 9. Recognition and securing of an office for the University Alumni Association within Adeta campus.
- Focus on entrepreneurship education through the newly branded Abdulraheem Oladimeji Centre for Entrepreneurial and Vocational Studies
- 11. Effective collaboration with several national and international institutions National Institute for Security Studies (NISS), Nigerian Army (NA), Institute for Peace and Conflict Resolution (IPCR), Chartered Institute of Stockbrokers (CIS), Cavalla International University (CIU), among others.
- 12. Ongoing construction of Moot Court at the Faculty of Law.
- 13. Review of Al-Hikmah University Law 2003 (as Amended) and approved by the National Universities Commission (NUC)
- 14. Improved and sustained students enrolment since assumption of office. For the first time in recent years, the University recorded a higher number of admitted regular students (1,287 in 2021 and 1,450 in 2022). Similarly, the Centre for Part-time and Professional Studies recorded 1,079 new students in various Part-time and Professional programmes in 2022.
- 15. Establishment and successful take-off of Al-Hikmah University International School to serve as feeder to the University.
- 16. Constitution of Advisory Committee on the establishment of Medical School.
- 17. Constitution of Senate Research Grant Committee with budgetary provision for individual and collaborative studies
- 18. Successful delivery of the University's maiden Inaugural Lecture which took place on 7th January, 2022, while the second lecture was held on Wednesday, 30th March, 2022
- 19. Successful accreditation of 23 academic programmes in March 2021

in which 22 of the programmes secured FULL ACCREDITATION STATUS and another batch of 11 academic programmes was accredited in January, 2022 with all the programmes securing FULL ACCREDITATION STATUS.

- 20. Robust support for the Faculty of Agriculture in Igbaja campus on crop production, animal husbandry and poultry
- 21. Concrete fencing of Atere and Igbaja campuses as a positive step in the direction of Safe School programme
- 22. Unveiling of 5-year Strategic Plan which has been approved by the University Council.

Challenges and Mitigating Strategic Plans:

- Inadequate funding To be mitigated through (i) improved enrolment drive; (ii) aggressive income generation by all units of the University; (iii) outreach efforts to foreign embassies; (iv) collaboration and partnership with supporting institutions and industry
- Lack of support from government To leverage on the current efforts by the Committee of Vice Chancellors & Registrars of Private Universities in Nigeria on international research grants.
- 3. **Lack of Lecture Theatres for large classes** To be addressed in the implementation of 2022-2026 Strategic Plan.
- 4. **Overcongestion of Adeta campus** Commencement of gradual movement plan to the University's permanent site at Atere Campus
- 5. Challenges of operating multi-campus system Provision of (i) affordable and accessible transportation; (ii) providing good road network; (iii) expansion of utilities, i.e., boreholes, stable power supply; (iv) janitorial services; (v) adequate security through fencing and efficient security personnel; and (vi) digital connectivity of the three campuses towards a truly "smart campus"
- 6. Challenge of meeting the demands of ever-increasing students' enrolment (i) Provision of more lecture rooms, hostel accommodation and offices; (ii) provision of other human and material resources required to meet NUC benchmark through fiscal/budgetary provisions7. Lastly, launching of an Endowment Fund is being proposed. It is hoped that this will go a long way in addressing the aforementioned challenges.


Appreciation:





ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION

- ii. Master's Degree: Applicants for academic Master's degree programmes who are graduates of Al-Hikmah University, Ilorin or any other recognized University must possess a minimum of Second Class Honours Degree (Lower Division), provided they score a minimum of 50% in the qualifying examinations to be administered by the University.
- iii. M.Phil.: Applicants with less than 3.5 on a 5.0 point scale or less than 3.0 on a 4.0 point scale or less than 60% scale in their Master's Programme are eligible for M.Phil. admission that runs for a minimum period of 12 months
