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

nterviewer: How did you secure the land for the university's Atere campus, especially being an area prone to land disputes?

Founder: The process of securing and developing land for Al-Hikmah university was challenging. Initially, the land remained unfenced, leading to encroachments. Some individuals even performed rituals on the land to claim it. However, with prayers and determination, we overcame these obstacles. We fenced the land and addressed disputes with clear documentation. Today, the land is secured, and we thank God for His guidance.

Interviewer: Al-Hikmah's university tuition fees are relatively low compared to other private universities in Nigeria. How do you sustain operations?

Founder: It is by God's mercy. Despite the modest fees, we follow the federal government's salary structure for our staff. Interviewer: What is the next step for Al-Hikmah university as it celebrates 20 years?



Interviewer: Sir, considering your achievements, what are you most grateful for?







Parents initially lacked confidence in sending their children to us, especially with tuition set at №250,000 annually, compared to ₹17,000 at the University of Ilorin for similar courses like Arabic and Islamic Studies," he explained. Despite these challenges, the team's innovative strategies, such as offering significant rebates for certain programmes, laid a solid foundation.

PROFESSOR MUSBAU ADEWUNMI AKANJI

Professor Akanji's tenure was marked by resilience and resourcefulness. Under his leadership, the university overcame financial constraints, secured essential partnerships, and established its core identity. "We started with three faculties and 70 students. Attracting both students and qualified lecturers was a challenge, but we were determined to uphold high standards," he said. One notable achievement was the emphasis on punctuality and discipline. "Respect for time became a cornerstone of our culture."







ounded in 2005 with a vision of academic excellence underpinned by strong Islamic values, Al-Hikmah University has carved a remarkable legacy over the past 20 years. From its modest beginnings with 70 students and three faculties, the institution has grown into a beacon of learning, currently serving over 15,000 students across multiple programs and campuses.

Al-Hikmah University was born from the efforts of Chief Dr. AbdurRaheem Oladimeji and the AbdurRaheem Oladimeji Islamic Foundation. Licensed in January 2005, the university began its operations the following year. "We were hell-bent on ensuring quality was not compromised," recalls Professor A.O.Y. Raji, Dean of the Postgraduate School. Early achievements included securing a solid academic and infrastructural base, with three faculties—Humanities, Natural and Applied Sciences, and Management Sciences—and just 12 lecture rooms at its Adeta campus.

The last 20 years have seen extraordinary growth in infrastructure. From just one campus and 12 lecture rooms, the university now boasts over 100 lecture halls across three campuses. Milestones in infrastructural development include the construction of a central administrative block, a 24-classroom complex at Adeta, and a multi-story science laboratory, made possible by partnerships with organizations like the Petroleum Technology Development Fund (PTDF) and individuals such as former Kano State Governor Malam Ibrahim Shekarau.

Between 2010 and 2017, Al-Hikmah made strides in upgrading its facilities, commissioning a CBT center, a university clinic, and expanding students accommodation to house over 3,000 students. Female students benefited from projects like the International Hostel and the Commasie Hostel, each reflecting the university's commitment to providing conducive living environments.



The academic journey of Al-Hikmah has been equally transformational. The initial 12 programmes have grown to over 50 undergraduate offerings and nearly 70 postgraduate programmes. Landmark achievements include the introduction of the Law programme and the establishment of the Faculty of Education. Today, the university is renowned for producing skilled graduates, with enrollment numbers swelling from 70 students at inception to over 15,000 across regular, part-time, and sandwich programs.

One pivotal moment came in 2008, when Al-Hikmah achieved 100% success in its first accreditation exercise conducted by the National Universities Commission (NUC). This laid the groundwork for consistent quality assurance and academic excellence, evidenced by the university's steady climb in rankings, including recognition from the Times Higher Education Ranking system.

This year's convocation ceremony is a testament to the university's growth, with 2,211 undergraduate and postgraduate students graduating—a significant leap from the fewer than 200 students at the first convocation. The university's achievements

extend beyond academics; its campuses are now fully tarred, with modern facilities and a dynamic fleet of over 25 vehicles supporting operations.




The Early Days
